CARF (formerly called the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities; accredits behavioral health agencies which meet rigorous standards

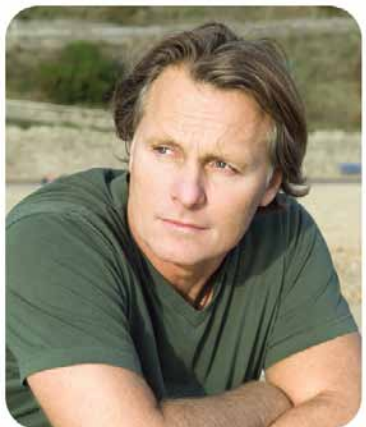

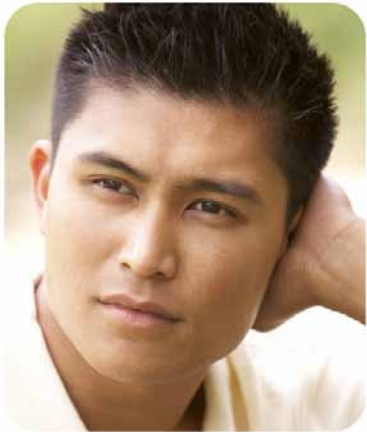
- One of Central Ohio's first community mental health agencies

Mental Health Snapshot



- Suicide rates at 10-yr high
- Murder-suicide rates tripled
- More 18-25 yr olds hospitalized for first time
- Suicide 3rd leading cause of death

Intervention and Prevention Services



- **At School Assistance Program**
 - 100+ middle & high school students
 - 86% showed improvement
- *renew*
 - Keeps young adults from going back to expensive state hospitals
 - 12% were readmitted vs. 47% in control group

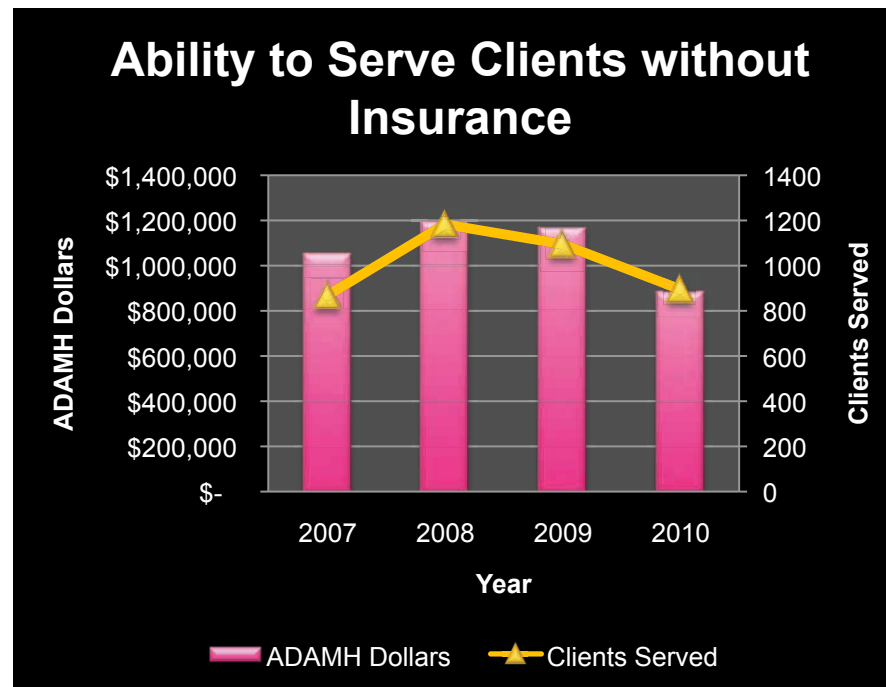
Intervention and Prevention Services



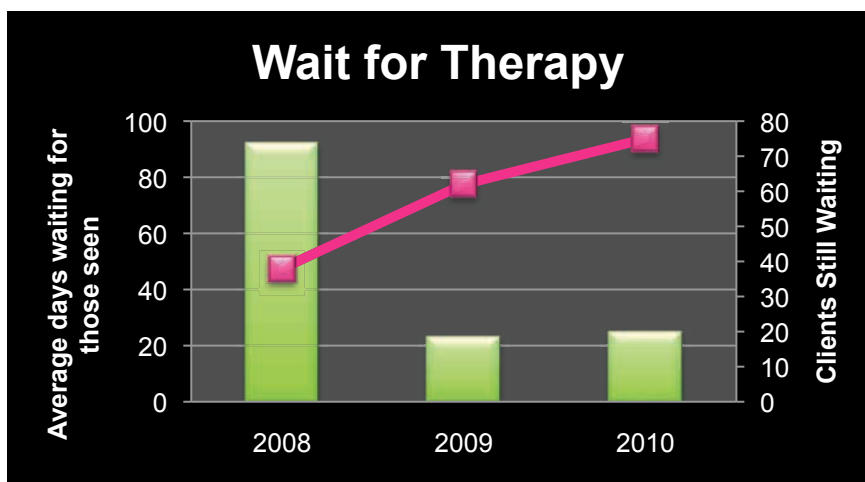
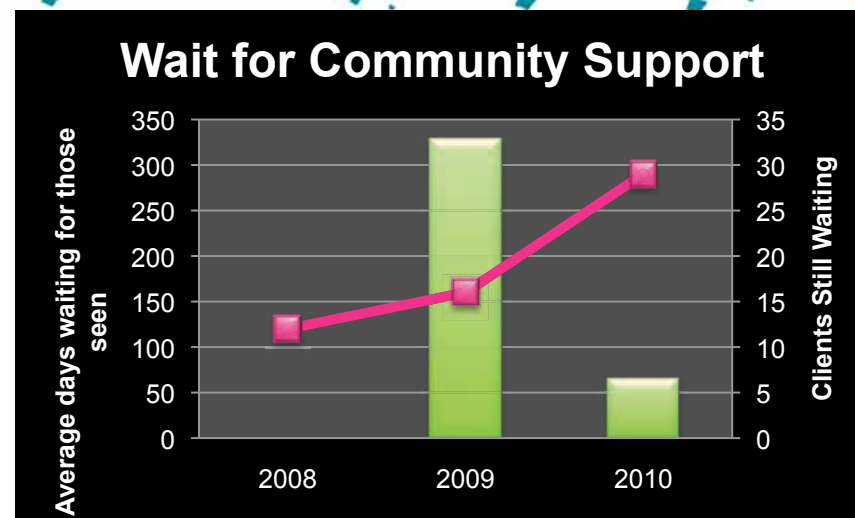
- Senior Program
