### **Older Adult Therapist- Fulltime**

**Older Adult Therapist**, counsel Older Adults (60 and over) both in office and in their homes. Job duties/requirements include, but are not limited to:

- One of the following licenses: Licensed Social Worker (LSW), Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC), Licensed Independent Social Workers (LISW), or Licensed Professional Clinical Counselor (LPCC).
- Individual and group counseling experience preferred.
- Ability to work at least one evening per week.
- Excellent communication, interpersonal skills and computer literacy are essential.

### **Substance Use Prevention Clinician – LISW, LPCC or Masters LSW/LPC and CDCA/LCDC/LICDC**

**Substance Use Prevention Clinicians** provide school-based substance use prevention services which will include working with students individually, in groups, referring to community resources and parent education workshops.

- Candidates must have experience working with clients with substance use disorders as well as children, adolescents and their parents
- School-based experience a plus
- Requires Master's degree, LSW/LISW or LPC/LPCC and CDCA/LCDC/LICDC

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## **Engagement Specialist - Fulltime**

- Supporting the recovery process for each assigned tenant.
- Assisting tenants with identifying and addressing barriers to success and to develop coping skills to live independently and as part of a community.
- Providing limited case management services
- Licensed Social Worker (LSW) or Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) preferred. Minimum Bachelor's Degree in Social Work or a related field is required.

## **Mental Health RN-Fulltime**
