“During the past five years I lost everything” Jeff says. When this successful business executive moved to Columbus to marry his childhood sweetheart, he left behind a career, a strong social network, friends, and family. Jeff was still grieving the deaths of both his parents and felt like “I had to start all over again.” He couldn’t find a job and his anger and sense of loss was beginning to stress his relations with his new wife.

“I am a control freak. As a recovering alcoholic, I have to be. I needed to find a balance, not blame other people, to accept the responsibility for my own actions and to regain my confidence....Concord gives me a safe, comfortable place that allows me to open up, to look at things in a different light, and to heal.”

During his fifteen months of counseling, the 59 year old has realized what he needs to work on to continue to grow personally and in his relationships. “You tune up your car, you do maintenance on your house, you take continuing education classes, why wouldn’t you take the time to get your life in balance so you can adapt to the changes life throws at you?”
