Engagement Specialists assist individuals with mental health and/or drug/alcohol issues who have experienced homelessness and now live in supportive housing. Job duties/requirements include, but are not limited to:

- Engaging tenants with activities and education both within the housing program and the outside community.
- Supporting the recovery process for each assigned tenant.
- Assisting tenants with identifying and addressing barriers to success and to develop coping skills to live independently and as part of a community.
- Providing limited case management services
- Licensed Social Worker (LSW) or Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) preferred. Minimum Bachelor's Degree in Social Work or a related field is required.

- Master's Degree in social work or related major, and independent licensure (LISW/LPCC); will consider Master's level LSW/LPC with clinical experience in a mental health or school setting.
